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**On Farm
Housing Grant Program**



On-Farm Housing Grant Program

With grant funds provided by the U.S. Department of Labor under the Workforce Investment & Opportunity Act (WIOA), Southeast Non-Profit Housing will provide financial assistance to farmers and growers who wish to upgrade and/or improve their farm labor housing.



Eligible Projects

The program is limited to farmers and growers who own existing farm labor housing that is in need of repairs and upgrades that will have a direct impact on the safety and health of farm workers.

Typical Examples

- Bathrooms and plumbing systems
- Kitchens and replacement of appliances
- Electrical heating and air condition systems
- Interior walls, floors, ceilings, doors, windows, and other major structural components
- Roof



Financial Assistance

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SENPB will provide a matching grant up to \$7,500 to eligible farmers and growers to repair and upgrade their existing farm labor housing. Farmers must agree to provide a matching financial amount or equivalent amount of \$1 for every \$1 provided by SENPB.

How to Apply

1. Schedule an initial inspection with SENPB staff.
2. Complete and sign the On-Farm Housing Grant Application. Complete Detail Work Write-up of work to be completed.
3. Sign the On-Farm Housing Grant Agreement. Agree to complete the work by completion date.
4. Notify SENPB when work is complete to schedule final inspection.
5. Submit all invoices and receipts to SENPB.
